**Purpose**

Articulation refers to the relationship between educational programs from the secondary through the post-secondary levels that are designed to provide a smooth transition for students from one educational program to another, and to grant credit, where appropriate, for previously attained knowledge and skills.

**Policy**

The College encourages articulation between programs offered at the College and similar programs offered at secondary or post-secondary levels. To ensure that articulation between programs at the high school and OTC and between OTC and other colleges is established on a permanent and educationally sound foundation, formal written articulation agreements with secondary and/or post-secondary institutions should be developed. Articulation agreements should be signed by the chief administrative officer and the chief academic officer of each institution involved. In instances, such as Tech Prep articulation agreements, several institutions may be involved in the articulation agreement.
